Peace of the Action --2nd Annual Art Show & Sale

Exhibition Guidelines

1. Theme: **PEACE of the ACTION**
2. Exhibition and sale will run for two weeks from September 25 to October 9, 2010.
3. Exhibitors may submit (**one to two**) two- or three-dimensional work for the exhibition. Due to space restrictions, FOR can only accept one piece.
4. Two-dimensional artwork should not exceed 22”X36” in size. Three-dimensional work should not exceed 24”X24”.
5. **There is an entry fee of \$20.**
6. **Application deadline is July 30, 2010. Artists will be notified after August 8, 2010, and art must be delivered to FOR by September 16, 2010.**
7. FOR encourages artists to work in non-toxic, environmentally friendly, or recycled materials.
8. The subject of the artwork must be presentable to viewers of all ages.
9. Artwork must be framed, wired and ready for conventional hanging. Media may include paintings, drawings, prints, photographs, or collages. Works on paper matted and unframed are acceptable, as long as, work is done for standard frame sizes.
10. Artwork is for sale. All sales and transfer of funds are the responsibility of FOR with 50% of each sale being a contribution to FOR. At the artist’s discretion, a higher percentage may be donated.
11. Each entry must include title, medium, date created and size – please use FOR entry form to simplify the process. Please include either a CD or photo of the artwork.
12. **Certificate of Insurance (COI)**
 - a. Artist must present a COI to FOR listing the value of the artwork (**for insurance purposes**).
 - b. If an artist **does not have** a COI for their work, they must sign a waiver stating FOR will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to their artwork.
13. The artist, or the artist’s representative, is responsible for delivery and pick-up of their work to the Fellowship of Reconciliation. 521 N. Broadway, Nyack, NY 10960.
